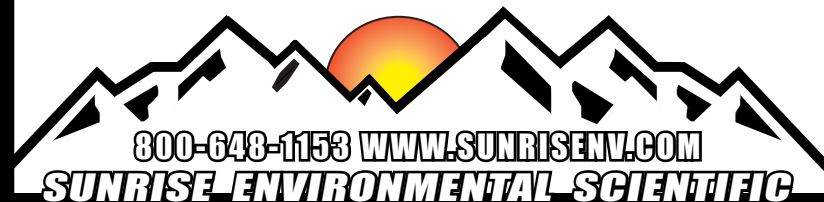
SUNRISE' STRONG ARM is perfect for cleaning concrete floors, and those tough areas that require an extra heavy-duty cleaner.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Heavy encrustation of oil, grease and dirt should be scraped and loosened with a scraper, the loosened debris swept away, and then cleaned with **STRONG ARM** as follows:

Wet area thoroughly with water (preferably hot water), then sprinkle **STRONG ARM** on the wet area at the rate of 2 to 4 ounces per 100 square feet. Allow cleaner to penetrate and solubilize the soil; scrub with a stiff brush, and hose surface with clean water.

For cleaning equipment such as garbage cans, dumpsters, garbage trucks, and similar areas where a water solution is more easily applied, make up a solution of 2 to 4 ounces of **STRONG ARM** per gallon of water. Hot water will dissolve the powder more quickly. Stir the solution until all of the powder is dissolved, and then apply the cleaning solution with mop, brush or spray. Agitate the solution into the soil, then hose away with clean water.

CAUTION: Corrosive, harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not ingest. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. If skin is contacted, wash with soap and water. If eyes are contacted, flush with water for 15 minutes. See a physician. Consult Material Safety Data Sheet for further information.
